


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



His past affiliations include World Health Organization, University of Kuopio, Finland, the National Institute for Health and Welfare in Helsinki, Finland, Danube-University Krems in Austria and King Abdulaziz University in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia.

His research interests include the epidemiology and prevention of non-communicable diseases such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease, cancer and dementia. He has coordinated numerous scientific research projects, and contributed many landmark studies. He has been involved in epidemiological studies in many countries in Europe and other regions of the world, e.g. China, India, Japan, Pacific Islands, Latin America, Middle East, USA, and Mauritius.

He initiated the Finnish Diabetes Prevention Study (DPS) that demonstrated a 58% reduction in incidence type 2 diabetes (T2D) with lifestyle intervention. This finding was later confirmed by similar trials from many countries, including USA, UK, Netherlands, Japan, China, India. The experiences from the DPS were used to design and implementation of a first-ever national diabetes prevention program in Finland. He developed a simple, non-laboratory T2D risk score FINDRISC (FINnish Diabetes Risk Score) that has been validated and applied widely in Europe and elsewhere.

He has received many prestigious scientific awards. He has been a faculty member in many international postgraduate training courses on diabetes and cardiovascular disease in many parts of the world. He has contributed to over 1700 scientific peer-reviewed publications, and is among the most cited authors in the field of diabetes worldwide (Thomson Reuters Highly Cited Researcher) with >125,000 citations. His h-index is 161.




